

## Immigration Scenarios

Scenarios of people wanting to immigrate as Skilled Workers to Canada. Calculate their points within the Six Selection Factors to see if they pass:

You are a 20 year old woman from Zimbabwe, Africa. You have 2 children. You have worked as a part time hairdresser for 2 years, as well as an unpaid mother and gardener (you grow your own food). You are very lucky to have a highschool education because your parents lived on very little so that they could send you (there are no public highschools in Zimbabwe - they are all private and cost a lot). You have the equivalent of 5,000\$ Canadian, and High speaking and listening English with no writing and reading. You want to immigrate because the current dictator of Zimbabwe, Robert Mugabe, sends his army of war veterans into small neighborhoods like your own to rape and beat people in order to maintain fearing support of his rule. You are afraid for your children and want to go to Canada.

You are a 36 year old man from France. You have worked as a professor at a university for 1 year, with a PhD in Economics. You want to immigrate to Canada because you have traveled there and appreciate the arts and culture, and have an HRDC confirmed job offer at a university in Montreal. You have no family. You have high proficiency in all 4 language skills in French and English. You have 80,000\$ Canadian.

You are a female doctor from the Philippines. You are 35 years old, and have been working full time as a doctor for 4 years. You have a PhD degree, and moderate reading and writing in English with basic speaking and listening. You want to immigrate to Canada because you have no children, and your cousins and their children have already immigrated to Canada. You have no confirmed job opportunities because your specific level of education from the Philippines is not recognized by Canada. You have 30,000\$ Canadian.

You are a male mechanic from Bosnia. You have been working full-time for over 10 years. You are 60, and have a family of 6. You speak basic English. You want to immigrate with your children so that they can have more opportunities since the Bosnian economy does not offer many jobs and most people are living in poverty. You have a rich cousin who immigrated to England and is offering to let you borrow as much money as it will take to immigrate.

You are a 38 year old woman from Australia. You have a bachelors degree in Anthropology and have been working full time as researcher and writer for the past 14 years. You have High proficiency in all 4 language skills in English, no children, and 30,000\$ Canadian. You want to immigrate to Canada because your sister lives there, and you have one year full-time authorized work lined up.
